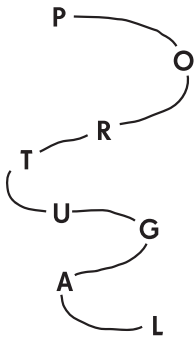

In 2013, "Vic+Flo Saw A Bear" won a Silver Bear in Berlinale. "Joy Of Man's Desiring" was selected for Berlinale Forum in 2014.
